

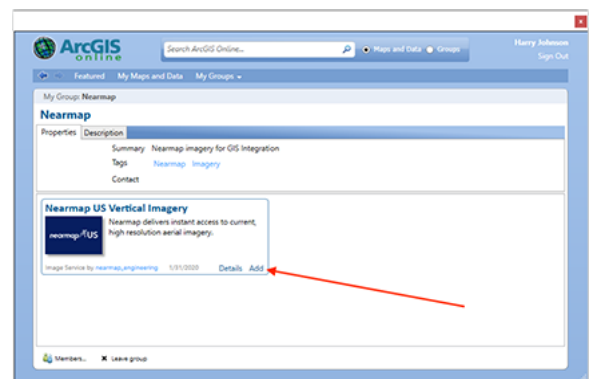
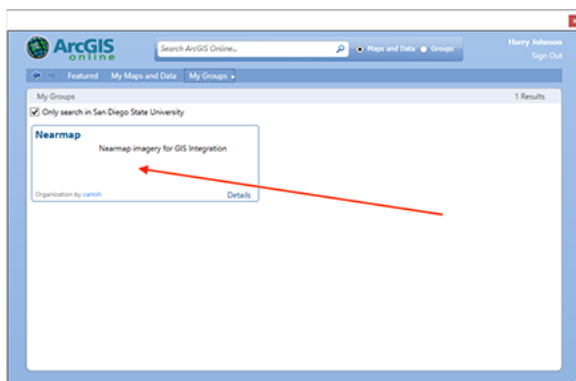
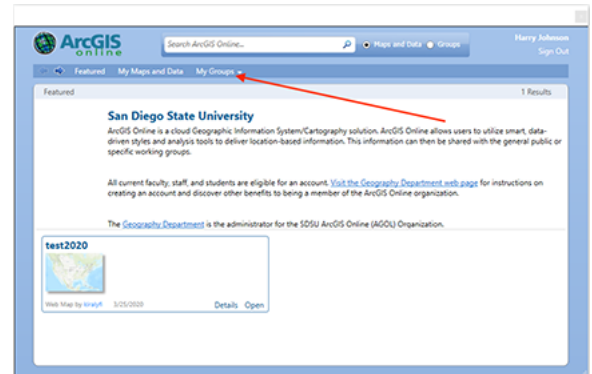
# Using Nearmap Imagery in ArcGIS Desktop 10.3 and above

## Sign into the SDSU Organization

1. Start ArcGIS Desktop
2. From **File** menu, select **Sign In**
3. Click **Sign in with Enterprise Login**
4. Enter the SDSU Organization: **sdsugeo**
5. Click **San Diego State University**
6. Enter SDSUid (@sdsu.edu) and password

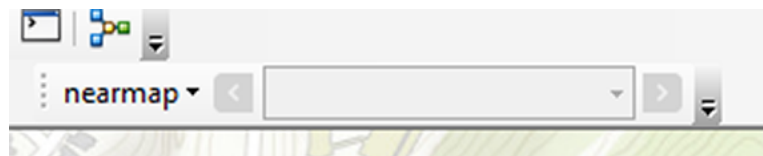
## Add the Nearmap Imagery

1. From **File** menu, select **ArcGIS Online...**
2. Click **My Groups**
3. Nearmap Item will appear
4. Double click the Nearmap Item
5. Click **Add** on the Nearmap Item at lower right



## Use Historical Imagery

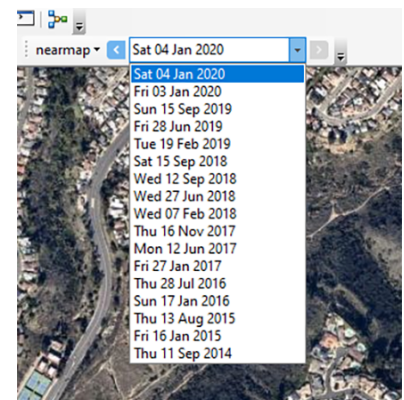
The **Nearmap Timeline Add-in** must be installed to use Historical Imagery.



When the Nearmap Imagery is displayed in the ArcMap window, you can click the **Date** dropdown for a list of available dates for the area that fits the window.

As you zoom and pan around the map, the list of available survey dates in the Date drop-down changes to show only the available survey dates for the area that fills your screen.

Click the **Back** and **Forward** arrows to display imagery from the previous or next available survey date.
